Know Ye that I the Said John A. Treutlin in the County of
Effingham of the State of Georgia, Planter for and in Considera-
tion of the love, good will and Affection which I Have for and
do bear towards my loving Brother Christian Treutlin

of the Same State and County Above mentioned, Planter -
Have given and Granted and by these presents do Freely,
Clearly, and Absolutely, Give and Grant unto the Said ~

Brother his heirs Executors and Administrators, All and
Singular my whole Estate both Real and Personal ~
Consisting of Lands Negroes Horses, &c, &c, and all other
things to me belonging, which I may or do justly Claim

as in Right My own as well movables as things ~
Immovables in whose ^{hands} possession, or Custody I ever the
may be or wheresoever the Same or any of them or
any part of them Can, Or may now or hereafter be found

Remainning To have and To Hold, ^{all} and Singular the Said
Estate unto the Said Christian Treutlin, his heirs
Executors and Administrators from hence forth for ever, as
his and their property Right Absolutely without any Manner

of Condition as I the Said John A. Treutlin do for ~
myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators ~
Covenant Grant to, and agree with him the Said Christ.
