Boy, Slave named June About Twelve years old,
Now in the Actual possession, being of Rhoda Hudson
Relict of the Aforesaid Robert the younger Deceased;
To have and to hold the Said Negro Boy Slave named
June, as aforesaid for ever, TO the Said Maxwell Hudson
his heirs Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to the only
proper use and behoof of the Said Maxwell, his heirs Ex^r
Administrators and Assigns for ever AND I the Said Rob^t
Hudson, the Said premises into the Aforesaid Maxwell
his heirs, Executors Administrators and Assigns, Against
me the Said Robert Hudson my Executors & Administrators
and all and Every other person & persons whatsoever
and will warrant, and for ever defend by these presents,
In Testimonie, whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Affixed my Seal this day of June, in the Year of
our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine, and
