Know all men by these presents, that William Wilson of George Town in the State of South Carolina for and in Consideration of the Regard & Esteem I have for my Daughter in Law Elizabeth Ford & Stephen Ford, her husband, both of the same place I have Lent them during their Joint Lives Eight Negroes, One wench Sebra, & her Two Children Named Fortune & Jeffery, one wench Cloe and three Children Named Sue, Jamine, and Rose, — one boy Rompy Together with their future Issue to and for their use During the aforesaid Term and at the Demise of my Said Daughter in Law for and in Consideration aforesaid I do hereby Give and Grant unto the Children of the said Elizabeth Ford, the Aforesaid Eight Negroes Named Sebra & Two Children Fortune and Jeffery, Cloe and Three Children, Sue, Jamine

and Rose, one boy pompy and their issue to be equally
Divided Between them Share and Share alike and
to ~~this~~ be their property for Ever, in Consideration of
which I have hereunto These presents Interchangeably
Set my hand and Seal this Eight Day of April In the
year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred & Eighty
Six ~
