Deed of Gift } To All People unto whom the
presents writing shall Come, I John Nevell Carpenter of
the County of Effingham, and State of Georgia do send
greeting; Know Ye that I the Said John Nevell for
Divers good Causes and Valuable Consideration
me hereunto moving have given and Granted and by
these presents do give Grant and Confirm unto my
Son Jacob Nevell of Great Ogeechee in the County
and State Aforesaid all and Singular, that Tract of
Land Containing Two hundred Acres Lying and being
in the State and County Aforesaid Bounded on New
Creek, Granted Samuel Carney on the 20. Day of
November 1769 as also Two other Tracts Containing
of Two Hundred Acres Each Tract bounded on
the above Tract Granted Samuel Carney to which
both the Said Tracts, was Granted unto John Nevell
on the Second Day of August 1786, And all the
above mentioned three Tracts of Land Containing
all together Six Hundred Acres, and bounded
as aforesaid, then I do Give and Grant and
Confirm unto my five Children to it Jacob Nevell
(Turn over)

Sarah Nevell, Mary Winslow, Francis Nevell,
and Elizabeth Nevell, all the Remainder part of
my personally Estate that is to say, all my Stock of
neat Cattle, Consisting of about forty head, and --
three horses, and a Small Gang of Hogs with all
my household goods and kitchen furniture of all
kinds whatsoever to my Said Son and Daughters to
be Equely Devided amongst them at my Death all
this I Beg and then Request, that my worthy --
friends Joshua Pearce the Elder and Joshua Pearce
the Younger do and they are hereby Vested with
full power to Devide or Cause the Same to be --
Equely Devided, all the Said Stock of ~~it~~ Stocks of
Neat Cattle, three Horses, Gang of hogs, Household
goods and kitchen furniture of all Kinds whatso-
ever to me belonging; To have and to hold all
and Singular the Said Lands goods, Cattle, horses,
hogs, Stuff whatsoever of me John Nevell unto
my Said Son Jacob Nevell and my four Daughters
Sarah Nevell, Mary Winslow, Francis Nevell,
and Elizabeth Nevell, their Executors, Administra-
tors and Assigns from henceforth to their own
proper Use and Uses thereof and therewith to
do Order and Dispose of at their wills and
Pleasure, as of their Own proper Goods and
Chattles freely and peaceably and quietly with-
out any manner of Lett Trouble or Deniel of
me the Said John Nevell; or any other person
or persons whatsoever of all which premises
the Said John Nevell have put my Said Son
Jacob Nevell and my four Daughters, Sarah
Nevell Mary Winslow, Francis Nevell,
and Elizabeth Nevell, in full and peaceable
possession, by Virtue hereof, in witness whereof
I the Said John Nevell, have hereunto Set my
hand and Seal the third Day of July one --
