Effingham County S.

To all to whom these presents Shall Come; -  
Know ye that I John Wilson Jun<sup>r</sup>; of the State  
and County aforesaid, Shoemaker; For and in  
Consideration of the Love Goodwill, and Affection  
which I have and do Bear, Towards Ephraim  
Tiner, Son of Elijah Tiner of same place, have  
given and Granted, and by these presents do freely  
give and grant unto the Said, Ephraim Tiner  
his heirs Executors, or Administrators, all and  
singular, that piece of Land, in the whole to -  
Contain Thirty Acres, whereon the above Men-  
tioned Elijah Tiner Now lives on; The Division  
Line to Begin at the Northwest Corner of the  
Hundred Acres whereon the Above Mentioned  
John Wilson Jun<sup>r</sup>; Now lives on, and to Stop  
on the South Line Somewhere about the Middle of  
Said South line, But so as to Leave the whole Branch  
or Stream whereon there is now a Grist Mill on the Said  
John Wilson Junior's Land, and that the Said Ephraim  
Tiner or Elijah Tiner, his Father, Shall not <sup>use</sup> or  
Dispose of the Said Thirty Acres of Land, before Mentioned  
and Described to any person or persons whatsoever during  
the life of the Above Mentioned John Wilson Junior without  
his Consent, of which Before the Signing of these  
Presents, I have Delivered him the Said Ephraim Tiner  
To have and to hold the Said Land with all and Every  
Convenience thereon, to him the Said Ephraim Tiner  
his heirs Executors, or Administrators, from henceforth  
and forever under the Restriction Above Written
