State of Georgia & Effingham County In the Name of god Amen, I Nathiel
Oatt of the State and County aforesaid
being of full age, of Body, yet of Sound and
Perfect understanding and memory, do make Constitute
and appoint this my last will and Testament in the
and words following (Viz) First I Give and bequeath
my body to the Earth from whence it was Taken in full
assurance of its Resurrection from thence at the last
Day, As for my Burial I Desire it may be Decent at
the Discretion of my Executors or Executrix or both as shall
be hereafter Mentioned Or named, As to my worldly
Estate I will and positively Order that it may be
in the way and manner as is hereafter Directed ~ ~

2. I Give and bequeath unto my well beloved Brother Godlip

Oatt One Two Year old heffer & Two Sow Shoots ~ ~

3. I Give and bequeath unto my Dearly beloved Wife ~ ~
Christiannah Elizabeth Oatt Fifty Acres of Land ~ ~

whereon I Now live, all my Stock of Cattle and Hogs
and a Mair, Bedding, Household furniture &c. to
be her Right and property after my Death to her for ever,
and last of all I Do Appoint my Dearly beloved Wife -
Christiannah Elizabeth Oatt to be my Sole Executrix
to this my last will and Testament, Signed and Sealed
with my hand this Twentyfifth of January 1794 and
by this Doth Disannul all other Testaments &c. ~ ~
