as above, Samuel Hudson, Robert Hudson, Mary Hudson;
and Maxfield Hudson, their heirs Executors Administrators
and Assigns for ever, All and Singular the goods and Chattles
that I now own and possess, or otherwise my goods and Chattles
which I possessed at the time of my Signing these presents as
is hereafter particularly Named, Or Described (Viz) one Negro
man Named King, One Negro Woman Named (Jancy), one Negro
Woman Named Lucy, Two feather beds, five Chairs, one wooden
Chest, Two wooden Tables, One Boefett, with Set of Crackery
One ginn Case, one bay Gelding, One Timber Carriage and Chain,
Three Iron pots, One Frying pan, Six pewter plates, Two Dishes
and five Spoons, a Feather Bed, One musket, (Gun) Two
weeding hoes & Two Axes, One Mans Saddle five Hundred &
Twenty five Acres of pine Lands, three old bed Steads, one
pail & one piggan, Three Earthen pans, Two Wooden bowles,
One Tea kettle, one Skillett, one pair of old Carriage Wheels,
one Set of Kniffe & forks, and One Spinning Wheel, observing
also with the Negroes Increase if any After the Date of these
Presents, at my Death and not before, as I wish to Reser-
ve the use of the Said property, unto myself and my
use During my life, and at my Death, Should it Son

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So happen that neither of the above named Children will be of Age, to manage, or have the Same in their possession by Law, then to be in the hands & possession of any True and Trusty friend as I may before my Death nominate, and Appoint; to Safe keep in Charge and Care untill they or ~~any~~ one becomes of Age, and as they arrive to the age of Maturity and as is allowed Commonly by Law; then to have, his, her, or their Share of the above property, it first being Equally Devided for them, to have Share, and Share, alike; and if one or more of them should die before they become of Age, then and in that Case the Survivor or Survivor to have the Said property, Share and Share Alike, and if only one to have the whole, and should it happen they all should die before they become of Age, then the Next Nearest heir at Law, to have and Demand and Recover the Same to be their, his, or her property for Ever, as also the first Named, Samuel Hudson; Robert Hudson, Mary Hudson, and Maxfield Hudson, to have the Same property as above Mentioned, and is hereby by me freely given to them, their heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for Ever, IN witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this first Day of July 1794. and in the fiftenth year of American Independency x x x x x x x x x x
