Record of Dorcas Gindrat's Last Will
and Testament * * * * * *

In the Name of God Amen, I Dorcas Gindrat being in a low State of Health & considering the uncertainty of life do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament, it is my Desire that my Negro Woman Nell should remain in the Possession of my Husband Henry Gindrat and to his use untill he marries again, and if he never Marries, to remain his own to the day of his death, and then to belong to my Daughter Mary Stafford; I give and Bequeath Nells Two Children that is to say Cornelius to my Daughter Dorcas, Flora to my Daughter Henrietta if Either my Daughters Dorcas or Henrietta should die before Either of them Comes of Age or Marries, the two Above Named Negro Children that is to say Cornelius and Flora to belong to the Survivor, it is further my Will that should Nell have any Children during the time that she is in the Possession of my Husband to be Equally Divided Between my other Children, Elizabeth Tison, William Stafford, & Seth Stafford and Lastly I also Constitute and Appoint my Husband Executor to this my Last Will and Testament - revoking and Disannulling all other Wills

Legacies and Bequests in any wise be- 78
-fore Willed or Bequeathed by me Confirm-
-ing this and no Other to be my Will and
Desire, In Witness whereof I have here-
-unto set my hand and Seal with the
Approbatton of my Husband This 9th day
of September in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred & Ninety Seven
Signed, Sealed, Published, Pronounced,
and Declared, by the within named
Dorcas Gindrat as her last Will and
Testament in the Presence of us who in
her presence & in the presence of Each &
Other have hereto Subscribed our Names
as Witnesses.
