John George Ziegler Deceased. ~ ~ ~ ~

In the Name of God Amen

I John George Ziegler of the County of Effingham
 in the State of Georgia / Planter / being very sick
 and Weak in body but of Perfect mind and Mem-
 ory thanks be given unto God; Calling unto mind
 the Mortality of my Body and knowing that
 it is appointed for all men once to die, do make
 and ordain this my Last Will and Testament that
 I do say principally and first of all I recommend
 my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that
 gave it me, and my Body I recommend to the
 Earth of Almighty God that gave it me and
 my to be Buried in decent Christian Burial
 at the discretion of my Executors: Nothing doubt-
 ing but as Touching at the General Resurrection
 I shall receive the Same again by the Mighty Power
 of God and as touching such worldly Estate where-
 with it has pleased God to bless me in this Life, I
 give, demise and dispose of the same in the follow-
 ing Manner and form Viz^t:

First it is my Will and I do ordain that all my law-
 ful Debts and funeral Expences shall be paid punc-
 tually paid and Discharged before any distribu-
 tion shall be made out of my Estate.

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my beloved son
 Emanuel, George and to his heirs and assigns
 forever fifty acres of land whereon he is dwelling
 and being a half part or more of a one hundred
 acre tract, and a part of another tract, say it
 being a part of three different surveys out of which
 three surveys he is to have fifty acres and no
 more nor any thing else out of my estate.
 Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto my other beloved
 son David, George and to his heirs and assigns
 forever two hundred acres of land on the second
 bridge branch being part of three different sur-
 veys but the said David is hereby bound to be
 obedient to his father and mother during
 their Natural life.
 Fourthly, I give and bequeath unto my wife below
 named Anna Catharina all the rest and residue
 of my real and personal Estate throughout the
 nature, Dutchess, Ulster and Plantation State
 Cattle, Hogs and Horses during her Natural
 life to live out of the same to use and maintain
 herself out of the same, but after her decease it
 shall be equally distributed amongst my children
 whatever I left except my ward son Emanuel shall
 not have any share more than what is first allotted
 him say fifty acres of land as aforesaid out of three
 several surveys.
 Fifthly and lastly I constitute make and appoint
 my well beloved wife Anna Catharina executor of
 the last will and testament
 and do hereby authorize, revoke and disannul all
 former and other wills by me in anywise made or
 made testifying and allowing this and no other to
 be my last will and testament.
