 amongst my Children, & with her to have a Childs share.
 Lastly all my Lands to be valued & equally divided
 amongst my Children, I Likewise nominate & appoint
 William Kennedy & Christopher Gugel together with my
 Son Matthew Rieser Executors of this my Last Will & Testa-
 ment, & I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all and
 every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests & Executors
 by me in anywise before named, willed & Bequeathed, ratifying
 & confirming this no other to be my Last Will & Testament. —
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
 Fifteenth day of December in the year of our Lord, One thousand
 Eight hundred & one —
