Georgia } In The Name of God Amen
Elbert County } I Joseph Ferry of the County
a person being of Sound mind and disposing
memory but weak in body and Celling to
mind the uncertainty of human existence
and the certainty of Death have thought
proper to make and Ordain This my last
Will and Testament in manner and form
following to wit, as touching my Spiritual
Concerns I resign my ^{mortar} body to its Mother
Earth from whence it came to be buried
in a decent manner at the discretion of my
Executor herein after named and my immortal
Soul to God who gave it—Trusting in the
merits of my Redeemer for the remission of all
my sins and as touching my Worldly Estate
which it hath pleased God in his great
goodness to bless me with I give and dispose
of in the following manner to wit,
Item 1st I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Judeth Ferry one tenth part of all my Estate
Real and Personal
Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my son Wm Ferry
after accounting for forty dollars heretofore given
one tenth of my Estate Real and Personal

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my Son Thomas Jerry
after accounting for ^{Libert County, Georgia Wills 1864 to 1866} ~~his share~~ and sixty dollars
heretofore given ^{www.georgiapioneers.com} one tenth part of my Estate real
and personal

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to ~~my son~~ Mrs J Jerry
Trustee for Sarah King his mother one tenth part of
my Estate real and personal

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lucy
Alexander wife of Elam Alexander after accounting
for one hundred and fifty Dollars heretofore given
one tenth part of my Estate real and personal

Item 4th I give and bequeath to the heirs of my daugh-
ter Mary Ward deceased one tenth part of my Estate
real and personal

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my Son James
Jerry one tenth part of my Estate real and personal

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my Son John W
Jerry after accounting for fifty dollars hereto-
fore given one tenth part of my Estate real
and personal

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Nancy Kelly wife of John Kelly one tenth
part of my Estate real and personal

Item 8th I give and bequeath to my Daughter
Frances Turner wife of James B Turner one
tenth part of my Estate real and personal

Item 9th I do hereby constitute and appoint my
Son James Jerry James B Turner and Francis
Guins my Executors to this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all others and date
bying and confirming this and this only
