Elbert County, Georgia Wills 1836 to 1860

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State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen.

Elbert County } I Nancy Walton being of sound and disposing
mind though weak in body and desirous
of making some disposition of my property do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament.

Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my grand children James
Thomas, Beatties, Tobitha Ann and Charlotte Virginian
Davis now the only children of Turner A. and Mary A.
Davis who was my daughter the whole of my property
consisting of one note against Lawrence P. P. Tate and
the other against Turner A. Davis to be equally divided
among them.

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint Turner A. Davis
sole executor to this my last will and Testament.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 10th day of October 1840.
