Second that part of my Estate which without the intervention
 of the Trust to be created in this Clause would be going to
 my Son William B Alexander under and by virtue of any
 part of this will the same I give and bequeath to my
 Son Thomas R Alexander and John B Alexander in Trust
 for the benefit of my said Son William B Alexander
 and his Children they the Said Trustees to have full power
 to sell reinvest rent Control and in all things to
 manage the same as they may think for the best advantage
 of my said Son William B Alexander and his Children

Third I appoint Thomas R Alexander Leonidas B Alexander and
 John B Alexander Executors of this my last will and
 Testament with full power to sell any part of my real
 Estate and to execute legal titles to the same with out
 an order of Court or any expenses what ever Intestimony
 of all which I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal
 this Twenty ninth day of November one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty four
