Will of Kelly Hopper Deed 1857

Georgia } I Kelly Hopper of said County do make
Elbert County } publish and declare this to be my last will and
Testament
First I direct all my Just Debts to be paid
Second I Give and bequeath to my Wife Sarah Hopper all the
house hold and Kitchen furniture now in about or belonging
to the house where I now live reside and also all the Horses
Cattle hogs and other Stock of Every description now on or
belonging to the plantation on which I reside and this
property is given to her in addition to what she would
otherwise be entitled to as one of my legates under this will
and as one of my heirs under the law of the land
Third all the rest of my property I give and bequeath to those
who would be entitled there to under the law of the land
if I had made no Will
Fourth I wish my Debts to be paid out of the property mentioned
in the Third Item of this Will if the same will suffice
before resorting to that mentioned in the Second Item
Fifth and I hereby authorize and empower my Executor hereafter named
to sell in his discretion at public or private sale any of the
property herein disposed of in furtherance of the purposes of this
Will
Sixth I hereby constitute and appoint Edmund D. Tate of Elbert
County Executor of this my last Will and Testament
