In the name of God amen. I Solomon Jones of the County of Elbert
and State of Georgia. being of sound mind and disposing memory
do publish this my last will and Testament in manner and
form following, to wit, First. I recommend my Spirit into the hands
of God who gave it me. and my body to be decently buried.
Second. I Leave to my son Thomas one gray Horse called Bill
and one Bed and one cow and calf and one sow and pig
and nine months schooling. This do. I leave to my son Wiley
one Horse to be worth sixty Dollars one Bed one cow and calf
and one sow and pigs. and nine months schooling the schooling
to be given him before he becomes of age and the above mentioned
property to be delivered when he becomes of age. Fourth. I leave
unto my beloved wife Elizabeth all the Ballance that I possess so
long as she lives and remains a widow. and at her death for it
all to be sold at Publick outcry and divided equally between
my six children. Lewis. Martha. William S. James. Thomas & Wiley
Fifth. I leave my beloved wife Executrix to manage during
her lifetime and widowhood. Sixth. I leave my son William
S. James Executor at the death of my wife Elizabeth this being
my last will revoking all other wills that I have made this

In the name of God Amen. I William Bibb Key of the state of Georgia
 & County of Elbert. knowing that it is appointed unto men once to
 die and being of sound mind & disposing memory do now make this
 my last will and Testament in manner & form as follows - Item
 the first I will first of all that all my just debts be truly & punctually
 paid. Item the second I will to five of my daughters (to wit) Elizabeth
 Bell. Margaret Goode. Returah Ham. Mary Bell & Lucy Mattox one
 dollar each in addition to what I have already given them and
 no more forever - I will to my loving wife Mourning Key all my
 lands & plantations whereon & contiguous to where I now live in-
 cluding my plantations on each side of the dry fork of falling ^{Creek} whereon
 Thomas C. Elliott now lives with also the same rented to Thomas S. Key
 the present year with that also in the occupancy of my son Chiles
 Key the present year - also four negroes (to wit) Senor & Fanny woman
 Malinda a girl & Jordan a Man. also two horses of her choice two
 cows & calves of her choice all my stock of hogs & geese my waggon
