my Remains Sumular to that over the Grave of my Father
Item 2nd I desire that all my Debts shall be promptly paid
Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved Mother Lucinda
Deadwyler my Two negroe Girls Malinda & Patience
Item 4th I give & bequeath to my Sister Mary E. Deadwyler my bed
& Bedstead my large Chest & iron bedstead Table & cloth
Item 5 I give and bequeath to my Sister Sarah P. Deadwyler my
Trunk and coverlid & picture frames & desire that my Executor

hereinafter named shall purchase out of my money for my said sister Sarah P. a ^{Elbert County Georgia Wills 1836 to 1860} ~~piece of land~~ ^{similar to the one bequeathed} above to my sister Mary E. and it is my will that my bed clothing be Equally divided between my two said sisters Mary E. & Sarah P.

Item 6th I will and desire that my Boy Emanuel shall be sold by my Executor hereinafter named and whatever may be necessary to place over my remains such a Tombstone as I have described be taken out of the proceeds of such sale

Item 7th I will and desire that the whole of the remainder of my Estate of what ever Nature be Equally divided share & share alike between all my Brothers & Sisters

Georgia } I Kelly Hopper of said County do make
Elbert County } publish and declare this to be my last will and
Testament

First I direct all my Just Debts to be paid

Second I Give and bequeath to my Wife Sarah Hopper all the
house hold and Kitchen furniture now in about or belonging
to the house where I now live reside and also all the Horses
Cattle hogs and other Stock of Every description now on or
belonging to the plantation on which I reside and this
property is Given to her in addition to what she would
otherwise be entitled to as one of my legates under this will
and as one of my heirs under the Law of the Land

Third all the rest of my property I give and bequeath to those
who would be entitled thereto under the Law of the Land
if I had made no Will

Fourth I wish my Debts to be paid out of the property mentioned
in the Third Item of this Will if the Same will sur~~plus~~

before resorting to that mentioned in the Second Item
Fifth and I hereby authorize and empower my Executor here after named
to sell in his discretion at public or private Sale any of the
