of my Estate both Real and Personal to her and for
her own proper use during her natural life and after
the death of my wife all the property both Real and
Personal I wish sold and the proceeds equally divided
amongst all of my Children share and share about
Equally between all both sons and daughters

6th I constitute and appoint my friend John McDonald
my sole Executor to execute this my last will and
Testament revoking all former wills or former testaments
