William Rich Will 1843

Georgia
 Elbert County ³ I William Rich of the State and County of said being of
 sound and disposing mind and memory do hereby make, publish
 and declare this to be my last will and testament
 Item 1st My Will and desire is that all of my property I hold together with the care
 and management of my Executors until all my just debt be paid and when
 my debts are paid my Will and desire is that my execs have a house to live
 a piece or the value of a good negro fellow or money as may be agreed upon
 by my Wife and her and that it be understood that each share be equal
 my Will is that the same time the above distribution is made that my Daughter
 Sarah A. C. Edwards have a negro Woman loaned to her during her life and
 then to the Children of her body said Negro and what may subsequently be

- Item 1st I have in a settlement with her mother or final settlement at her Mother's death all to go into the possession of John Rich as trustee for Sarah A. C. Edwards
- Item 2nd My will and desire is that my son David A. Rich when he comes of Age have a House valued at One hundred Dollars or One hundred Dollars or more
- Item 3rd My Will is that my beloved Wife Sarah Rich have the Whole of the balance of my estate both real and personal during her Natural life or Widowhood and at her death I give and bequeath ^{the whole of my estate} to my five Children to them and their heirs forever except Sarah A. C. Edwards in trust as above described but if my Wife should Marry my will is that on her intermarriage that the property be equally divided between my Wife & Children each to have an equal share to them and their heirs forever except Sarah A. C. Edwards before excepted
- Item 4th My will and desire is that in a final settlement of my estate that each of my Children that have received property or money from me in my life time and have been charged for the same and when I have taken up their Notes do account for the same in the settlement of their distributive share as it is stated in my book of accounts or may appear by the Notes themselves
- *Item 5th My will is that my son John Rich take charge of all the property falling to Sarah A. C. Edwards and manage the same for the benefit of her and her children & if he should die before she does or before a settlement with her children that in that case the Court of Ordinary appoint a successor to settle the same
- Item 6th I do hereby nominate and appoints my Wife Sarah Rich and my son John Rich and David Rich to execute this my last Will and Testament Signed sealed and published in presence of us this 9th April 1842.
