 sealed with our seals this twenty fifth day of December
 eighteen hundred and fifty five

The condition of the above obligation is such
 that where as above bound John H. Griffith
 has this day applied to me Anniston Ordinary
 of said county for and has obtained
 temporary letters of administration of the goods
 and chattels, rights and credits of Anna Rogers
 deceased now in the above bound John H. Griffith
 and legally preserve and collect from whosoever has or has
 the goods, chattels, rights and credits and effects of the
 said Anna Rogers Deceased and make make or cause
 to be made a true and perfect inventory of all said
 estate and the same being made so preserve do
 surrender up such estate and effects with the
 inventory afore said unto the legal administrator
 on or before the first Monday in July next or
 so soon there after as the Court of Ordinary
 may direct with all other duties and things
 therein and faithfully perform the trust reposed
 in him then this obligation to be void either will
 to remain in full force in law
