Tammam County deceased do make a true and perfect inventory
of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the
deceased which have or shall come to their hands possession

do there bind possession of any other person or persons
for him and the same do make do exhibit unto the said
court of ordinary when they shall be there unto required and
such goods chattels and credits do sell and truly
administer according to law and do make a true and
and true account of these doings and doings the
