Security are held and firmly bound unto the ordinary of said
county and his successor in office in the full and full sum of
Six hundred & fifty dollars for the payment of which sum we
do the said ordinary and his successors well bind ourselves
our heirs executors and administrators in the whole and for
the whole sum jointly and severally by these presents
sealed with our seals and dated this fifth day of
November 1860

The condition of the above obligation
is such that if the above bound James M. Casada
administrator of the Goods and chattels and credits John
Casada deceased late of said ^{Fannin} County do make a true
and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods chattels
and credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to
the hands possession or knowledge of the said James M. Casada
or into the hands or possession of any other person for him
and the same do make do exhibit into the said court
of Ordinary when he shall be thereunto required and
such goods chattels and credits do well and truly ad-
minister according to law and do make a just and
true account of his actings and doing thereon when
thereunto required by the Superior court or ordinary
for said county and all the rest of the goods chattels
and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account
of the said administration the same being first allowed by the
Ordinary shall deliver and pay to such persons respectively as are
entitled to the same by law and if it shall hereafter appear
that any last will and Testament was made by the said deceased
and the same be proved before the Ordinary and Executor
of said deceased a certificate of the probate thereof and the said
