in you I do hereby commit the tuition and guardianship
of the said James B. Robertson to you the said Joseph
Shepherd you assenting thereto by your acceptance
of these letters herein charging you that you maintain
and cause to be educated said orphan in such a
manner as shall be suitable to his interest and
circumstances during his minority and that inquire into
and take charge of the estate both real or personal and
and all other things to do which by law you are
to do for your said ward of all which a true and
perfect account you shall render to the July Term
of said court of Ordinary every year during your
continuance in office and lastly I do hereby constitute
and appoint you the said Joseph Shepherd guardian
of the afore said James B. Robertson during his minor
