sum of fifty dollars for the payment of which
sum to the said Ordinary and his successors we
bind our selves our heirs executors and adminis-
trators in the whole and for the whole sum joint
and severally firmly by these presents; sealed with our
seals and dated this First day of November 1838

The condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound William Franklin administra-
tor of the goods chattels and credits of Thomas J
Frederick deceased late of the state of Virginia
do make a true and perfect inventory of all and
singular the goods chattels and credits of the said
deceased which have or shall come to the hands
possession or knowledge of said William Franklin
or unto the hands or possession of any other person
for him and the same do make do exhibit unto
said court of Ordinary when he shall be there
unto required and all the rest of the goods chattels
and credits which shall be found upon the ac-
count of said administration the same being
first allowed by the ordinary shall deliver

and pay to such person ~~respectfully~~ as are entitled to the same by law, and if it shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased and the same being proved before the ordinary and the executor obtain a certificate of probate there of and the said William Franklin do in such case if required render and deliver up the said letters of administration then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force
