- 1st I will my Body to the dust with Decent Burial
- 2nd I will my Spirit to god who give it
- 3rd I will my beloved wife Glorissa C. Cox three hundred
and Eighty seven dollars that I now have on hand I
also live my wife two Cows & two heifers and one Bull
three years old I also give my wife one Gray filly three years
old now in the possession of Giles G. Cox I also give my
wife all the house hold & Kitchen furniture that she had
when we was married I also give her one Red turned bed
stead one big wheel & Reel and trunk and one pair of
cotton cards and one large wash pot. I also give her my
wife one sad Saddle & Bridle. I also give my wife all the
pots & dealph ware knives & forks I also give her my churn
Jars & water vessels I also give my wife all my chairs &
loom I also give her my wife two new hoes two pair
of plow gears I also give my wife three turning plows
& three Seats with all the compliments connected together
Mrs. Mattocks & one Springing has two shovels one
Spade one Sythe & cradle and moing Sythe & one Pryer bar
I also give my wife white Iron that is up stores in the
big house I also give my wife two falling Axes one two
inch auger & one inch & half Auger & one inch Auger & one
three quarter Auger & one half inch Auger also chisels to follow
these augers or as near as possible, I also give my wife one
hansaw & two drawing knives I also give her Churn Books
& one atlas marked with the letters C.C. on the back of
them I also give her all the cloathing & wool & cotton &
Thread that we have on hand together with all the im-
plements connected with the loom necessary to make cloth

my wife her bee stands. I also give my wife my entire
stock of hogs and ten head of sheep I also give my
wife what provisions we now have on hand with
our pigs crop I also give my wife my ~~hay~~ and corn
& meal sacks & Measures & tubs & Barrels & Jugs
I also give my wife two Iron wedges & two pair
trowsers

I also my wife my plantation below the cross fence eight
years I also give my the meadow above the cross fence eight
years to my wife & after eight year I want the prop-
erty sold & Equally divided with my wife this is my plan
ation & then what other lands I have that lies South of
my plantation to gather with my North Carolina lands
& I want Equally divided made of the money with my
wife & all the heirs that is both sets of children
my lot of land that lies north west corner was with
my plantation I give to my two youngest children Sarah
J. Coit and James M. Coit. I also give these two
last named children what I please I have I also
want my two youngest children to have one bed
apiece with necessary covering I want Sarah
J. to have the Red bedstead that sits in the Room
I also give this little girl one trunk & wheel
I give my lands above the cross fence with the except
of meadow with the new ground to daughter in my
Legg eight years with the house she now lives in
& truck patches around it provided her husband
dont come home I give my buggy & my gray mare to
my wife I want the Balance of my property sold
& equally divided with all my heirs Lisy Stephens

I want my two sons Hampton James & Willson
Stephens to be my Executors of this my last will
