ourselves our heirs, executors and administrators of us
and each of us firmly by these presents subscribed with our
hands and sealed with our seals this 17th day of June 1834
The condition of ~~the~~ above obligation is such that where
as the above bound William M. Denton has this day applied
to James Kincaid Ordinary of said County for and has obtain-
ed Temporary letters of administrators of the goods and chattles
rights and credit of John Patterson deceased now if the
above bound William M. Denton shall carefully collect
and preserve from waste or loss all the goods chattles and
effects of the said John Patterson deceased and shall make
or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of
all such estate and the same being so preserved do surrender
up such estate and effects with the inventory afore said
unto the legal and proper administrator on or before the
first Monday of August next or so soon thereafter as
the Court of Ordinary shall direct with all his other act-
ings and doings there in and faithfully perform the trust
reposed in him then this obligation to be void otherwise
to remain in full force in law
