The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Elisha Garland administrator of the goods chattels and credits of Wm. E. Garland deceased late of Hammin county do make a perfect inventory of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the said Wm. E. Garland deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Elisha Garland or into the hand or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same do exhibit into the said court of ordinary when there he shall be there unto required, and such goods chattels and credits do well and truly administer according to law and do make a just and true account of his doings and dealings there as when required by the superior court or ordinary for said county and all the rest of the goods chattels and credits which shall be found remaining upon the account of the said administration the same being first allowed the ordinary shall deliver and pay to such persons respectively as are intitled there to the same by law and if it shall here after appear that any last will and testament was made by the said deceased and the same be proved before the court of ordinary the executor obtain

a certificate of probate thereof and the said Elisha Garland
do in such cases required render and deliver up the
said letters of administration then this obligation to be
said also remain in full force
