

State of Georgia in the County of Floyd I, David H. H. do hereby certify that the within and having attained advanced age and being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me. I desire that my body be buried in a Christianlike manner and after my decease my Executor shall exert a suitable mortuary fund there according to his taste and discretion over my remains. I desire that my just debts be paid out of my effects as soon as it can be done after my death.

I desire that I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Daniel two negroes to wit John a man about sixty years old known in my family as old John Rhoda his wife about the same age known in my family as old Rhoda also Martha a young negro Woman about seventy years of age and her fourteen increase, Henry a boy about eighteen years old Charlotte a young woman about sixteen years of age and her fourteen increase, Hannah a girl about fourteen years of age and her fourteen increase, also a tract of land in Floyd County known as lot number two hundred and ten (210) in the first District and fourth section known as some woods and one other tract or lot of land known as number one hundred and seventy three in fourth District and fourth section of said County. Also two other negroes one a boy named Jack about nine years old & Rhoda a girl about eleven years old also all of my household and Kitchen furniture and two good mules of her own selection out of the stock of mules on hand. I desire that she have the use of most cattle of her own selection out of the stock of cattle on hand at the time of my death also twenty head of hogs and two head of sheep of her own selection out of the stock that may be on hand at the time of my death and the use of corn & cotton that may be on hand at the time of my death, all of the property specified in this last of my will to be possessed by my said wife during natural life or under her & at her death or marriage to go to my three children to wit John, David & Mary known as John, David & Mary, whom I recognize as my legitimate son by Mary Ann Josephine Daniel & Patsy Mary Daniel being children of said Mary Ann & David.

I desire that I give and bequeath to my daughter Josephine Daniel the following lot of land lying in Chattooga County known as No. Eighty-two in the fourth District and fourth section No. Forty-two in the 10th District & fourth section also eight acres adjoining said lot number not well located also ten acres more it being the land on which my mill now stands also the following named negroes to wit a man about 35 years old and his wife Mary about thirty three years old, also a man about 18 years of age, David a woman about 16 years old & her children Eliza & Henry, Henry and child born about 2 years old, John a man about 25 years old, Peter a man about thirty five years old, David a woman about 15 years old, John a girl about 11 years of age, Harry a boy about four years of age, John a boy about 2 years old, Charles a boy about two years old, George a boy about 1 1/2 years of age and his wife Clara about 30 years of age, George a boy about 3 years of age, Patsy a girl about 5 years of age, David a boy about 1 year old, John a boy about 3 years of age, & Hampton a boy about 1 year of age.

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Item 5th I give and bequeath to my son Frederick Daniel the following named negroes, to wit: a man about 37 years of age Anne and a woman about 40 years old both the negroes a woman about 15 years old William a boy about 10 years old George a boy about 10 years old Leahy a boy about 10 years of age River a boy about 8 years old Caroline a girl about 5 years old Ruth a boy about one year old Rob a man about twenty six years of age Marinda a woman about 26 years of age Henry a girl about 5 years of age The daughter of Marinda a girl a woman about 26 years old

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my illegitimate son Phoenix Daniel previously known as Johnson Daniel and son of Mary Dan the mother of my daughter Josephine and son of Mary Daniel. The following named negroes to wit: Charlotte a woman about 68 years of age Malinda a woman about 75 years of age & William her son about 10 years of age Minerva a woman about 26 years and her child about eight months old Anne and Mattie Harriet a woman about 17 years old also a tract of land lying in the County containing three hundred six and a half acres more or less situate in the place that I now own in that County

Item 7th I will that all my personal property not disposed of by the foregoing Slaves of this will be sold by my executor and the proceeds after paying my just debts and the legal Administration of this will be equally divided between my three children Josephine Daniel & Johnson.

Item 8th I hereby constitute and appoint Hezekiah B. Bump to execute this my last will and Testament.

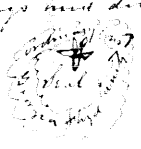
