Henry Baker and Elizabeth his wife and all the legitimate
children here after born of the said Elizabeth Baker and
Henry Baker her husband the following property to wit
one thousand acres of land more or less lying in Warren
County where on I now live adjoining Williams land.

I do promising that Keenan and Mitchell it is my
desire desire and wish that the above named my
debtors be well provided for and treated with kindness
and humanity in consequence of their faithful &
their old age and shall conditions be that William Stratton

Marshall Taylor William Keenan Walter Amy Mary
Afford Eliza John Hobbs and others his and her
just and lawful debts all the debts and personal debts of every
kind except one hundred dollars

Item 2nd I give and bequeath to William Baker fifty acres
of land where he now lives of the one thousand acres last
disposed of in the first clause for and during his natural
life and at his death to revert to and become the property
of the children of Henry Baker and Elizabeth his wife

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto Jonathan Baker William
Baker and the legitimate children as specified in the
first clause of Henry Baker and Elizabeth Baker his wife
all my estate both real and personal of every kind
and nature whatever not otherwise disposed of in
this my last will and testament

To be sold and equally divided share and share alike
between the said Jonathan Baker William Baker and
the legitimate children of Henry Baker and Elizabeth
Baker his wife

Item 4th It is my will and desire that all my estate give
and bequeath to the legitimate children of Henry
Baker and Elizabeth Baker his wife both real and
personal as mentioned in ^{this} my (last) will and
testament shall evermore together in the possession

and be divided equally among the said Henry and Elizabeth Barron share and share alike and they and each of them shall severally arrive to the years of age

Provided they said children should marry according to the will and contents of their father Henry Barron and the said child or children shall not have nor receive part or portion of said bequest property but the same to be equally divided among the said children while they live and further if in life when said child or children may be then I give and bequest to Judy and Manning two Dutch such her old and full servants and one hundred dollars Harrow a slave which I owe him the said Harrow for his faithful use and industry to be raised out of the present year crop and the other amount to said old servants to be raised out of the property to be sold in the third slave

Item 6. It is my will and desire that Henry Barron my beloved son shall receive out the property will be to the said Henry Barron children a good and competent support for and during his natural life appointed and ordered

Finally I constitute John Harrow and Henry Barron my beloved brother my true and lawful executor of this my last will and Testament declaring this and this only to be my last will and Testament this fiftenth 15 day of July 1862,
