

Georgia By the Honorable Justices Lambeth ordinary in
Chancery and for said County, Thomas James B. Waterfield
late of this county deceased does institute having while he lived
and at the time of his death done estate real and personal
within the County aforesaid by means whereof the full dispo-
sition and power of granting the Administration of the
estate of the said deceased, and also a final disposition from
the same to the ordinary aforesaid, this of right being he
deeming that the same may be well and truly Administered
and legally disposed of do hereby grant unto William J.
Price, Administrator full power by the line of these
presents to Administer the entire estate both real and personal
of said deceased, which to him is his life, lands and at the
time of his death did belong and to sell, demand sue for
recover and receive the same and to pay the debt in which
the deceased stood bound, so far forth as his assets will
satisfy according to law, and then the balance jointly
to pay over to the legal heirs and distributees of the said
deceased, and the said William J. Price having given bond
and security and taken the oath and performed all other
requirements required by law necessary to his full qualification
as Administrator he is by order of said ordinary, and by
virtue of these presents ordained, constituted and appointed Adminis-
trator of the whole estate, real and personal of said deceased
since under my commission and of office, on the first day of

State of Georgia, Where all men by these presents that we 11th
Chancery and for said County, David S. Burdick and Francis
J. Sullivan County are held and firmly bound unto Jesse Lambeth
ordinary in and for said County and his successors in office
in the sum of twenty thousand dollars to the payment of
which cost and bond to be made we bind ourselves our heirs
executors and Administrators of us and each of us jointly
by these presents, submitted with our chances and sealed with
our seals and dates this 11th day of August 1882

The Consideration of the above obligation is such that whereas the
above named William J. Price on this day appeared in
Jesse Lambeth ordinary of said County for and has
obtained a full power of Administration of the
goods and chattels Rights and credits of John S. Burnett
deceased, Now if the above named David S. Burdick and
Francis J. Sullivan shall faithfully collect and preserve from waste or loss all
the goods chattels and effects of the said John S. Burnett
deceased and shall make in course to be made in
time and perfect satisfaction of all such debts and
the same being so preserved do surrender up with
