State of Georgia, In the name of God Amen
I, Francis M. Gandy of said county and
disposing mind and memory
knowing that I must shortly depart this life and
right and proper both as respect my family and
myself that I shall make a disposition of the property
with which a kind Providence has blessed me
I do therefore make this my last will and Testament
hereby declaring and intending all others by me
heretofore made

1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in
decent and Christian like manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life my soul
a trust and return to rest with the God who
gave it as I hope for Salvation through the
merits of a blessed Saviour and Saviour Jesus
Christ

2nd I desire and direct that my just debts be paid
without delay by my executor hereinafter naming
and approved

3rd I will and bequeath to my sister Elizabeth
J. Gandy and Hannah Gandy one hundred
dollars each out of my estate to be paid after
the payment of my just debts

4th I desire & direct that the balance of my estate after
payment of my just debts and the legacies bequeathed
in and under the things equally divided between my sons
Henry & Isaac and James & Isaac I desire that my
personal property be sold to pay my debts and that the
residue of my estate be divided equally between my sons
Henry & Isaac and James & Isaac my sons
Henry & Isaac remain unmarried and my youngest
son Isaac a child receives twenty one years of age
and not above that age my son Isaac to receive
the same between them
