

Register of Verrell H Cochran's will

The will of Verrell H Cochran made and declared by him on the 24 day of December 1863 in his presence and the following circumstances and in these words the said Verrell H Cochran being at his own house in Forsyth County Georgia on the 26 day of December 1863 being near unto death in his last sickness from which he had suffered but a short time while the undersigned were present waiting on him after calling on Verrell H Cochran to hear testimony of what he should say Isaac J Henderson and Sarah J Cochran being present heard the declaration he declared as his last will in the following words; Verrell, I shall have to leave you, and want you to wind up my business and attend to it for me, for I can not do it myself, I want you to get my will and not will one thing to one and another thing to another but I want all the property to remain as is until the youngest child becomes of age and then sell and divide it equally between them all; Soon after the speaking of these words he died on the 28 day of December 1863 Given under our hands this first day of January 1864 Signed V H Cochran
