I desire and bequith to my wife Charity and my youngest
Son Dammie Chewman Garrett Two lots of land as follows Able 3rd
Four hundred and ninety one (4) Township Dist. and 0 Section
and 42 (6) Five hundred and twenty six (4) Dist. V D Section containing
Eighty acres more or less with the improvements thereon. Which Property
not to be disposed of in any way; to be cultivated for the support of the family
until Dammie Chewman comes of age. Should Dammie Chewman die
before he comes of age; the said Property described will revert to my wife
Charity; or should my wife Charity die before Dammie Chewman come of age
the same Property will revert to him and when the said Dammie O.
comes of age he will dispose of said Property as he may think best
Able 4th

I desire and direct that at my death there be of corn & fodder meat and such
other things as may be set apart to be raised and set apart for a years support
to the extent of Two hundred and fifty Dollars and if not sufficient of those
things on hand to come to that amount to be made to the family out of other
Property. Able 5th

I desire and desire that if on hand at my death there should
be a horse for the same to be set apart for the use of the family to work the farm
also on such stock; such as Cows Hogs and sheep as will be sufficient
for the use of the family on the farm also all the family utensils also on
such of the household and kitchen furniture set apart as my ex-
ecutors for the family. Able 6th

I desire and direct that the residue of my property both real and personal be sold by Executors and the proceeds after the expenses are complied with to be paid as follows

1st That Thomas Newman does be set apart the interest of which shall go for the education of Darnice Newman until he comes of age and should the over interest not be sufficient to give him a good English education then to draw on the Principal 2nd

I desire that ten dollars be paid to Josephine Hendrix Garrett's daughter to assist in her education & then the balance of the property to be equally divided between Hendrix Garrett Jos Garrett John Garrett Jasper Green and Mary Powell daughter of Allen Brown Art 6

I hereby constitute and appoint my son Jos. S. Garrett and my worthy friend Herman S. Benson Executors to this my last will and testament this 9 day of June 1869
