Children of my Deceased son James Dollar the sum of five Dollars

Item 3rd = I give to my beloved sister in Law Margaret Gentry One
feather bed and furniture One Sow and pigs and One Cow & calf.

Item 4th = I give to my beloved wife Tempe Dollar who is aff-
licted The Land and plantation in which I live, being four forty
acre Lots less six acres, heretofore sold by me to W. L. Bell and R. P.
Lester, and all the ballance of my property of whatsoever kind to be
absolutely hers,

Item 5th = I will and desire that my Executor
shall not make any Return to the Court of Ordinary, Then no Expenses
will be incurred in the management of my Estate after the proof and
Record of this will, = Item 6th = I hereby nominate and appoint my

my beloved Wife Tempe Dollar Executrix of this my last will and
