3^d I do sell all my property to the highest bidder
 at a time and place agreed upon by
 a majority of my legal heirs and after
 paying all my just debts and Burial
 expences and after paying for a Marble
 Box to be placed over the Grave of myself
 and of my husband Samuel Holbrook and
 after paying all expences for services rendered
 and writing on me during my sickness ~~and~~
 the remainder if any to equally divided amo-
 ngst my legal heirs

4th I reserve unto my self for my own use one square
 acre of land for a Burial Ground the
 grave of my husband Samuel Holbrook
 being the center of said square acre which
 same was omitted in a deed lately made
 from my self to my son S B Holbrook and
 is to be hereafter interlined in said deed
 I further choose my son S B Holbrook &
 S W Holbrook as my executors signed and
 made in presence of us viz (1) Hannah Holbrook
 & (2) Samuel Holbrook

The Last Will & Testament of John Broadwell

Georgia } In the name of God Amen
County } of John Broadwell of the said State

and County being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart from this world I deem it right and proper both as respect myself and my family that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me; therefore I make this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other heretofore made by me;

Item first; I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it, as I hope for eternal salvation through the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed for twenty five years

Item second I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid as soon as convenient by my executor hereinafter named as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed of their right especially as there is no necessity for delay

Item third I give and devise to my beloved wife Anne with whom I have since in the strictest quiet and love for about thirty eight years a beautiful support for the proceeds of the real estate belonging to me and also that all necessary expenses may occur be paid from the proceeds

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the same for her benefit and comfort during her natural life

Item fourth I give and bequeath to my daughter Gwertha Wilkins wife of Wm Wilkins three hundred dollars during her life then to be returned to the executor of my estate or will and to be equally divided between my other heirs provided she the said Gwertha Wilkins should die without heirs

Item fifth I give and bequeath to my son John V Broadwell three hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever

Item sixth I give and bequeath to my sister Elizabeth Broadwell one hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever

Item seventh I give and bequeath to my grandson son of John V Broadwell via William Broadwell three hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever

I appoint my trusty and worthy friend William V Riddle Guardian of the said sum of money the person and property of my said grandson William until he the said grandson is twenty years of age at which time the said Guardian shall pay over to him the said money

Item 8th I give and bequeath to my daughter Louisa C Williams and her husband John C Williams to them and their heirs forever
