I Alexander McFee of the County
Cherokee County } and State aforesaid being of
advanced age knowing the uncer-
tainty of life deem it right & proper both as
respect myself and my family to make a disposition
of the property not with which a kind providence
has blessed me.

Wherefore I hereby make this my last will
and testament revoking all others hereto-
fore made by me viz

Item 1st I desire that my body be buried in
my family grave yard near the residence
of Mr Williams of said County in
Christian like manner suitable to my cir-
cumstances.

Item 2nd I direct that all my just debt be paid by
my proper representatives hereinafter named
without any unnecessary delay & that all that
due me be collected in as early as convenient

Item 3rd I give to my beloved wife Harriet Mc-
Fee lot of land No. on which I
now live together with all of the building
Archeard and other appurtenances thereon
also fraction of ten acres more or less
lying broad side adjoining said lot both
South of said fraction described in the
J. R. Thompsons deed to me & also my
bay horse named Ephraim also my new
buggy & harness also my new wagon &
harness the white cow & half one
I give to my wife a good horse

The Side Saddle and plow Stick. I set plus some gear
a certain white heifer now about ten months
old also all the household and kitchen furniture
two not hereinafter disposed of, in this will
also twelve months support out of the corn like
meat and other provisions that I may have on
hand at the time of my death.

Item 4.

I give to my daughter Margaret McAffee
the cow and calf, 1 Bed, 1 Box, 1 Stove, & 1 Box furniture
as she has now in possession also all her
crochery ware which she has of her own.

Item 5.

I give to my son John McAffee the horse
called Philo which he has now in posses-
sion together with my saddle & bridle also
lot of land etc. — adjoining lands
of Mr Hallman James & Blackstock; also
one cow and calf or money enough to
purchase a cow and calf; One plough Stock
set plough gear and plows; One sow & pigs
if no pigs one brood sow one cluck and
I give my carpenter's tools.

Item 6.

I Direct that after all the above property
is given off, as specified then my
town lot in the town of Dawsonville
be to my remaining lot of land here
together with all of the remainder of
my personal property not given off
be sold by my representatives & the
proceeds arising therefrom be equal-
ly divided among all my children
by my first and last wife and if
any of the dead their legal heirs to
receive their part my wife to be
an equal heir with my children.

Item 7

I hereby appoint my beloved wife Harriet
& Alfred my Executors & my nephew Elijah
& Alfred my Executor of this my last
will and Testament

In witness whereof I have
hereunto signed my name & set my seal
while of sound disposing mind and
memory June 24th 1865

Codicil

I wish what Confederate money I have
on hand at my death to be equally divided
between all my children & my wife as
specified in Item 6 & further that if
any of my heirs as enumerated in item
6th become dissatisfied with the disposi-
tion I have made and attack or
undertake to break this will then the
one or ones so undertaking should not
receive any part of my estate. To be my
last will. Given under my hand & seal 24th June 1865
