 by me at any time heretofore made; And first
 I commit my soul to God who gave it trusting in
 his mercy for life and salvation in the world to come
 And my body I desire to have buried in a decent &
 respectable manner at the burying ground at Abbeys
 Church in Forsyth County by the side of my wife and to
 a head and foot stone of marble be put up similar
 to the one to my wife now deceased

Art 1st I desire and request that all of my just debt
 be paid by my Executors hereafter appointed

Art 2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Flora
 & a certain Negro Girl named Mary about fifteen
 years old with her increase.

Art 3rd I give and bequeath to my son Henry
 Edwin a certain Negro boy named David about
 nine years of age

Art 4th

I desire in the event that Mary or David should either
 of them die before the Flora & or Henry & become of
 age in that case an other Negro of the same value or
 other property be set apart of the same nature in the
 place of the one which may die

Art 5th

I desire and bequeath to my Daughter Flora
 & the Gold watch and other jewelry which belongs
 to my wife Jane

I desire and request all of the

I desire and bequeath to my son Henry & a good
 horse when he comes of age

to be furnished by my Executors

I desire and direct that all of the Beds and bed clothing
and furniture and every thing of that nature be equally
divided between my two children Eliza & Henry E
Art 18

I desire and request that the residue of my negroes
with their increase be kept until the children become
of age then be equally divided between them with the
providge of the two negroes David & Nancy now husband
and wife be sold a part to one of the children and
kept together

Art 19 I desire and request that Eliza & Henry E be
sent to good schools and receive good education & should
the interest of the money not be sufficient for that
purpose to use of the principal sufficient to carry out
this request

Art 10 I desire and request that my farm in Henry's
County with all my stock and the residue of all my
property not heretofore not specially disposed of
be sold and the proceeds thereof be equally divided
between my two children Eliza & Henry E
Art 11

I desire and direct that in case either of my
two children Eliza & Henry E should die before
they come of age then for the other one to inherit
all the property and in the event that both of the
children should die before they become of age
that their bed clothing & other things be apart to
Eliza & in article 7 be equally divided between
my mother's Jane & Sanford and Caroline & her
representatives

Art 12 I hereby constitute and appoint Benjamin S
George my Executor of this my last and
testament This 30th of December 1867
