

Last Will of Sumpter L. Owen

Georgia } I, Sumpter L. Owen, of said State
Forsyth County } and County, being of sound and dis-
-posing mind and memory, do make
this my last Will and Testament:

Item first: I desire to be buried in a decent and
respectable manner, and that my Soul may
return to God who gave it.

Item second: I desire that all my just debts be paid
out of my Estate.

Item third: I give and bequeath unto my Wife
Elizabeth M. Owen, the following property, to wit:
Lots of Land Numbers, 1328, 1329, 1325, $3\frac{3}{4}$ on
Lot of Land no 1263, 6 acres of Lot 1197, one
acre of Lot no 1214 - all in the 14 - District
first Section of said County and also, all my
Personal Property, during her natural life,
and at her death, I desire that my property be
divided among my children as follows:

Item fourth: I will and bequeath unto my two Sons,
John W. Owen and James H. Owen, the following
Lots of Land, to wit: 1328, 1329 and 1325, 14-
Dist. first Section of said County. I desire that they
John W. Owen and James H. Owen, give to my two
Daughters, Martha L. Owen and Nancy J. Flannery
One Hundred Dollars each, as their part of said Land.

Item fifth: I give and bequeath to my other Daughter,
Mary E. Owen, after the death of my Wife Elizabeth
M. Owen, the following Lands $3\frac{3}{4}$ acres on Lot
No 1263 - 6 acres of Lot No 1197, One acre of Lot
No 1214 - all in the 14 - Dist. first Section of
said County.

Item sixth: I will and bequeath unto my Grand
Son, Jasper M. Owen, and my Grand Daughter
Eliza Childers, Five Dollars each to be paid out
of the Estate, and if any remainder left.

Personal Property, to be equally divided between
my two Daughters, Mary C. Owen and Nancy
J. Flournoy;
Item Seventh; I hereby constitute and appoint
my two Sons, John W. Owen and James H. Owen
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
