 during her life time or widowhood provided she marries.
 the property all to be sold and her to have a child's part.
 If she remains single till her decease then all the remaining
 property after putting her away decently to be sold and
 equally divided amongst all my children. —

Item 2nd I hereby nominate constitute & appoint my wife Nancy
 Whitmire my executrix of this my last will and Testament
 and I hereby revoke and disannul all other will heretofore by me
 made, and recognizing this as my last will and Testament.
