sound disposing mind and memory, knowing
that I must shortly depart this life; deep
(dum*) it right and proper both as it respects
my family & myself; that I should make
a disposition with which a kind
Providence has helped me;
I do therefore make this my last Will
& Testament hereby annulling & revoking
all others by me heretofore made

First I desire and direct that my body be
buried in a decent & Christian like
manner suitable to my Condition in life
My Soul I trust shall return to rest
with God who gave it, as I trust hope
for Salvation through the atonement
and merits of the Lord & Saviour
Jesus Christ

Second I desire & direct that all my just
debts be paid without delay by

my Executors hereinafter appointed named
and appointed;

Thirdly. I desire that all my children be
made equal in advancement & heirs
-for made to them by me;

Fourthly I desire and it is my will that
all the rest of my property both real
& personal whatever, and wherever it
may be; be sold by my executor
according to the laws of Georgia
and equally divided between my
beloved wife and children share
and share alike; The amount ~~of~~
given to my daughter Mary C. Cantrell
is given to her not subject to the
debts liabilities or control of present
or any future husband; also the part
and amount given to my daughter
Martha C. Jordan likewise given
to her not subject to the debts liabil-
ities or control of her present or
any future husband

Fifthly Mr. Ron Jefferson P. Williams who died
in the State of Texas left one daughter
(name unknown) Should she be in life
he hereafter legally indentured and
apply for the same it is my will
and desire that she have three
hundred dollars of my estate

Sixthly My wife having of her own will
and accord chosen to take
a child's part of my estate
is to be in full extinguishment

Her whole right to answer in my real estate

Seventhly I hereby constitute and appoint my
Son Wm R Williams Executor of the
last will Testament
Signed William S Williams Seal

Williams as his last will & testament

who subscribed our names hereto in
presence of said Testator at his special
instance and request, in presence of
each other, this 16th Jan'y 1873
