The Last Will & Testament of
John G. Gott

Georgia } I John G. Gott of the County
Forsyth County } & State aforesaid being of advanced
age and infirm and being admonished
that I must soon die do make Ordain
and publish this my last Will and
testament hereby revoking all others hereto-
fore made by me.

Item 1st

When my Soul returns to the God who
gave it I wish my body buried in a
decent and Christian-like manner

Item 2^d

I wish all my just debts to be paid if
any such exists against me by my executor's
as soon as practicable

Item 3^d

Having heretofore given to my children Martin
Gott now deceased Susan Vincher Mary H.
Gott Wasea Gott now deceased and Sherry
Nelson amounts advanced to them each
ranging from eight to fifteen hundred
dollars and not having now enough or more
than enough property to make my other child-
ren equal with them it is my will that
they keep the amounts respectively ad-
vance to them heretofore and they are
to receive nothing more out of my
estate

Item 4th

I hereby give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Mary H. Gott all of my property
both real and personal for and during

the period of her natural life and of which she
is to be supported and at her death or intermarriage
the said property or its proceeds when sold
to be equally divided between and among
Mary J. Thompson, Maria M. Galt my daughter
hers and George Thomas Monroe my grandson
and orphan son of my dear daughter
Maria my said wife I hereby direct to
give out of the above property to my
grandson James J. Kincher upon his coming
at the age of twenty one years the sum of
fifty dollars

Item 5th

In the event that either Mary J. Thompson
Maria M. Galt or George Thomas Monroe should
die without issue before the death of the
said Mary M. Galt then at her death
the share of such deceased legatee is to be
equally divided between the other two

Item 6th

I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my
beloved wife Mary M. Galt my executrix
of this my last will and Testament and
I hereby direct that after an Inventory shall
have been made out and recorded on the
Ordinance office no annual returns shall
be made and no more expense be in
incurred than is absolutely necessary
