all my Estate both Real & Personal should Equally
be divided between my brothers & their heirs after their
decease And do hereby ^{constitute} name & appoint my truly
friend Nathl. Bell & Michael M. Payne my sole & sole
Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby disannulling
revoaking all other will or wills heretofore by me made and
do hereby confirm this to be my last Will & Testament

same and by virtue thereof I do hereby set my hand
and seal This the Twenty sixth day of May Eighteen
hundred & Eleven
