In the name of God Amen -

I, Ann Payne Senior, of the State of Georgia and County of Franklin, being old and Considerably infirm in Body, but of sound mind & disposing memory, Calling to mind the mortality of my Body, & knowing that it is appointed for all ones to die, do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament - That is to say, principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it, and my body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of Executors - And as touching my interest in the present Lottery, if it should be my fortune to draw either Gold or land or both, I give and dispose of the same in the following manner & form, First it is my will and desire, if I should be fortunate drawer in the present Lottery, that there should be an equal distribution of the same amongst my seven Children or their representations in the following manner - To my Eldest son Maxfield H. Payne one seventh part, to my Eldest daughter Elizabeth Payne one seventh part, to my son Thomas Payne one seventh part, to my third son

45. David Payne, first seventh part - Is my second daughter Nancy Burnett one seventh part during her life, and at her death to be equally divided amongst her own ^{born} Children. Is my grand Children the Children of my daughter Polly Chatham one seventh part - Is my grand Children, the Children of my daughter Ruthy Chatham one seventh part. And it my desire that if there should be anything to distribute amongst the above named Legates, that what is coming to my daughters Polly & Ruthy's Children should remain in the hands of my Executors and paid out to them as they come of age to receive it, I do hereby Constitute and Ordain Masfield H Payne, Thomas Payne, and David Payne my first second and third sons, Executors of this my last will and Testament, sealed signed, and published this 15th of February 1833 -
