I will that at the death of my beloved wife that my estate if any remains be sold, and equally divided with my six Children, and I also will that my beloved wife Lucetta Leach be and is my Executrix to act on the above will, Signed, sealed and delivered in presence of the undersigned, this 22nd of April in the year of our Lord 1835.
