Bobo gave his bond in his lifetime, to make
titles to a tract of land described in the bond
annexed to the petition, & that the said Lewis
Bobo departed this life without executing said
titles, all concerned are hereby notified that
after the expiration of three months, if good
Cause is not shown to the contrary, the Court will
direct the Administrators of said deceased, to
make titles in terms of the act of Assembly in
such case made and provided

In the name of God Amen I Daniel Bush of
the County of Franklin in the state of Georgia
being weak in body, but of a sound mind
& perfect memory, thank be to God, in the
first place I resign my soul to God who
gave it, in the next place I distribute my
worldly estate in the following manner (to wit)
I give & bequeath to my daughter Emily & the
lawful heirs of her body - one negro girl named
Phillis about sixteen years old - I give and
bequeath to my daughter Susannah Holland, &
to the lawful heirs of her body, one negro girl
named Betty about sixteen years old, I give
and bequeath to my daughter Susannah Morris
and to the lawful heirs of her body one negro
girl named Hannah about nine years old,
also one negro boy named David about
Eight years old, I give and bequeath to my daugh-
ter Lydia, & the lawful heirs of her body -
(to wit) one negro girl named Patsy about
thirteen years old, and one negro boy named
Sim about seven years old, - I give and
bequeath to my son John Bush one negro

Boy named Ned, about twenty years of age,
together with my two stills - I give and bequeath to
my son William Bush, one negro boy named
Died E, about twelve years old, I also give and
bequeath to my son William one other negro boy
named Hampton, about ten years old -
I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Bush the whole
of this plantation wherein I now live, containing
two hundred Eighty seven and a half acres -
more or less - also one hundred acres, including
the place where the still houses stands, and all the
appurtenances belonging to the said two tracts of
land to him the said Thomas and his heirs forever,
I also give to my said son Thomas one negro
boy named Peter, about seven years old, but be
it further understood, that this tract of land
wherein I now live is to be at the disposal of
my beloved wife Elizabeth Bush during her nat-
-ural life, and then went to my son Thomas -
I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Bush
the following property to be at her disposal during
her natural life or widowhood, afterwards
to be equally divided amongst all my sons &
daughters (taken), ~~there are~~ negroes - one negro man
named Will, one negro woman named Emily,
one negro man named George, one negro man
Farrish & Sam, still, Annas, Isaac, Filly,
Kagar, Charles, & one girl named Linder, and one
boy named Harry, I also give & bequeath to my
beloved wife all my stock of Horses, cattle, Hogs,
sheep and all my plantation tools, household and
kitchen furniture, together with my blacksmith
tools, Ratifying and allowing the foregoing to be
this my last will & Testament. I do also constitute &
appoint Isaac Bush on, James Freeman and my
beloved wife Elizabeth Bush to be my lawful
Executors to this my last will and Testament -

I Edward Price of the State of Georgia
Franklin County - being very sick, weak in body,
but of perfect mind & memory, thanks be given
unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of
my body & knowing that it is appointed for
all men one to die, do make & ordain this
my last will & Testament (that is to say) Prin-
cipally and first of all I give and bequeath
my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that
gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth
to be buried in a decent Christian burial, at
the discretion of my Executors - Sarah Price
and Willis Walton, trusting doubting but at
the general Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty Power of God -
And as touching such worldly Estate where with
it pleased God to bless me in this life, I
give, devise & dispose of the same in the fol-
lowing manner, and first, I give and bequeath
to Sarah my dearly beloved wife, the upper
half of my land that I now live upon, with
all the ~~improvements~~ goods & farming utensils
& all my carpenters tools & cropper tools, also all
my horses, cattle, sheep & hogs - to be her prop-
erty - so long as she remains my widow, also
