memory, calling into mind the mortality of my-
do make this my last will & Testament,
that is to say, first of all I recommend my
soul into the hands of God who gave it, and
my Body to the Earth, to be buried in decent
Christian Burial - As to my worldly goods
wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this
life, I give and bequeath in the following ma-
anner - I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Daughter Olympia Burr Morton, and to her
him forever, four negr. slaves named, Sam,
Tanner, Sether, & Abner - & their increase, and
I further give & Bequeath unto my said Daughter,
all my stock of Horses, cattle, Sedge, household
and kitchen furniture - It is my will desire
and request that my said Daughter should
remain in the care of Francis Calloway and
lately his wife, in the raising and teaching her
in her Education in the structure & administration
of the Lord, I give & Bequeath the
tract of land wherein I now live, containing
two hundred and fifty acres more or less, to
the said Francis Calloway and to his heirs
forever. It is my further will and desire that
after my decease the said Francis Calloway

shall have immediate possession of all the above
property, for the benefit of my said daughter and
himself, and that my Executor do give to the said
Frances one half of the profits arising from the
before mentioned Negroes, exclusive of the increase,
and the other half to be put to interest for the
benefit of my said daughter, and that the
present crop of cotton now in my possession
be carried to Charleston, and sold to the best
advantage for cash, and what I am indebted
to John Stral to be paid out of the money
arising from the sale of the said cotton, &
the balance to be converted to the use of my
said daughter. And lastly I hereby appoint
Samuel Lurou, Joseph Chandler Esqr. William
Calloway, Francis Calloway, and the reverend
John Cleveland to be the Executors of this my
last will & Testament. In the testimony of the
above and foregoing writing to be my last will
and Testament, I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this third day of January Eighteenth hun=
-dred and six -
