Commit to the earth at the discretion of my
Executors herein after named. It is my desire that
my son Charles Tony but be an Executor to my
will and settle all my just debts
And I give and bequeath unto my ^{beloved} wife Nancy Tony
my plantation wherein I now live during her natural
life
I Give and bequeath unto her five negroes to wit
Joe and his wife Reuben + Le + Peter my stock
of horses cattle hogs sheep with my farming tools
also my household and kitchen furniture to
have and to hold during her natural life time
thus at her decease for the Remainder of the property
to be equally divided amongst my live children
to wit Susanah A Scott Mary Anderson Robert
N Tony Charles Tony Jr Nancy S Stonewall
Laurany S Stonewall Charles Tony but

lying on the Middle Fork of Broad River
and likewise one other Tract containing six
and eight acres adjoining the same to Thomas
Davis and likewise a tract of one hundred
acres adjoining the same the place wherein
the said Micajah now lives Granted
to Jacob Pendleton
