Georgia In the name of God -
Franklin County I David Anthony being in
perfect mind and memory
calling to mind the mortality of the body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men to die
do make and ordain this my last will and
testament that is to say principally and first
of all I give and recommend my soul into
the hands of Almighty God who gave it and
my body I recommend to the earth to be buried
in decent order at the discretion of my friends
nothing doubting that at the general resurrection
I shall receive the same by the mighty power of
God - and as touching such worldly Estate
wherein it has pleased God to bless me with
first I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth Anthony
the land whereon she now lives and Eight
Negroes namely Pat Martha and her five
children Mary with the Stock household
and Kitchen furniture and all plantation
utensils to keep during her life and at her
death all the above named property Except
Mary I give to my son Martin Anthony

I give May at the death of my wife to be
equally divided between all her children except
Elizabeth Anthony and Anna widows of Stephen
children. I give to the said Anna Chandler a
note of hand against Stephen Chandler for
fifty one dollars and fifty cents & three dollars
I give three negroes namely Celia Eastern & Emil
two lots of land one lot now lying in Baker
County Ga one lot in Irwin County Ga one
note of hand against Wyatt Chandler for eight
even dollars one note of hand against Allen
Chandler for fifty dollars to be equally divi
ded between the children of my wife except
Elizabeth Anthony and Anna Chandler
wifes of Stephen Chandler. These to have
whenever they may apply for it

I give one note of hand against John Chandler
for two hundred and twenty five dollars to
my wife for her use. I give to my son Martin
Anthony one hundred acres of land wherever
he now lives for his own forever I appoint my
son Martin Anthony and my wife Elizabeth
Anthony to execute my will ratifying this and
no other to be my will and testament annulling
all former wills and bequests by me made in
writing whereof I have herewith set my hand
and first set my seal the day and year

Georgia I, Elias Burgess last being low in
Franklin County's health and knowing that it is once
appointed for all men to die and
feeling that I am now sound in mind and
feeling a desire for the welfare of my Children
to wit James Samuel Evan and Benjamin it
is therefore my desire for them to divide my
personal property and household furniture
together with my plantation tools and implements
and crop for the ensuing year after Samuel
takes his part for making and attending the
same + it is therefore my desire also for
the aforesaid James Samuel Evan and Benja
min to divide the same equally between them
+ if they cannot do the same equally and
agreeable to choose men or a man a piece
let it be valued to them and if the proper
ty cannot be allotted off equally let them
take it and let it be made up to them
out of the effects of the land + also for the
same to be at my disposal while I am
