In the name of God Amen, I David Caudell of
the State of Georgia & County of Franklin, being very
sick & weak in body, but of perfect mind & memory,
thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the
mortality of my body, & knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die, do make & ordain my last
will & Testament that is to say, principally & first
of all, I give & recommend my soul unto the hand
of Almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend
to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial
at the discretion of my executors, nothing doubting
but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God, and
as touching such worldly estate wherewith is has
pleased God to bless me in this life, I give & dispose
of the same in the following manner & form,
I give and bequeath to Elizabeth my dearly
beloved wife & Zeliana my daughter and ord that
my wife goes with if it lives. Eighty acres of land
which I now live, & one word more with a white

36 - That we have all read her Cow & two heifers & their increase, & twelve head of hogs and all the household & kitchen furniture, & moveable effects. Also I make constitute & ordain my Elizabeth my sole Executrix of this my last will & Testament full and singular my lands, messuages & Tenements by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed, and I hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all and every other former Testament, will, legacies, Bequests, & Executors by me in any wise before named, willed, and bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 30th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty nine —
