witnessed of all I give & bequeath my soul unto
Almighty God that gave it & my Body to be com-
mitted to the Earth in a decent Christian Burial at the
discretion of my Executors & as touching my
worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to be-
stow me in this life I give & dispose of the same in the
following manner & form that is to say First I
will & becommend the payment of all my just
Debts

Secondly I give & bequeath unto my four Daughters Anne
Carnies, Sarah & Mary one half of the whole of my
Estate Real & personal Except & except the Tract of
Land wherein I now live

Thirdly I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Frances
Christian & my three sons Drury B, Thomas C
John A, the remaining half of my Estate real
personal together with the Tract of Land wherein
I now live which said Tract of Land shall be
& enjoyed by my Beloved wife Frances during
life & at her Death it shall be equally divided
between my three above mentioned sons

Fourthly I ordain constitute & appoint my beloved wife
Frances Christian Executor & my friends
Thomas Jones & George Atwood Executors of
my last will In Testimony whereof I have here-
unto set my hand & seal This 24th day of February 1825
