1st I Give & bequeath to my beloved wife Ann Carroll all my Estate both Real and personal to use at her discretion and (with the exception of eight Negroes which I have this day conveyed to my Grands Children to wit, Hais M Neal Mary P Neal Mely M Neal D H Neal

2nd I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ann Carroll all my notes & accounts which are due and coming to me in any way whatever

3rd & lastly I hereby ordain constitute and appoint my wife Ann Carroll John McNeal and Edward W Mayfield Executors & Executor of this my last will & testament hereby ratifying and acknowledging this and no other as such
